

CAFE MERANO

Finish:

Cedar gets bolder, cocoa turns darker, and espresso notes emerge. Clean pepper on the retrohale and a long, sweet finish with zero harshness.

Middle:

The flavors deepen. Cocoa, warm cinnamon, and mineral creaminess rise to the front. Thick smoke, balanced spice, and richer body without losing smoothness.

Start:

Smooth cedar, a touch of pepper, and a natural sweetness from the Jalapa influence. Creamy, floral, and welcoming, a smooth opening.



Finish:

The final stretch grows richer and more complex. Jamastran leaf offers clean earth and soft leather, while Copan contributes dark cocoa and a hint of espresso. Pepper becomes more pronounced on the retrohale, but the smoke stays smooth with a lingering sweet-spice finish.

Middle:

As the burn reaches the Habano and binder more fully, the body deepens. Notes of honey, spice, and toasted nuts take the lead. The Pueblo Nuevo binder brings earthy richness and subtle herbal tones, while Jalapa adds its signature natural sweetness.

Start:

The Connecticut stripe opens the cigar with creamy sweetness, soft cedar, and a touch of vanilla. The Habano adds a light pepper kick to balance the smooth intro. Expect a warm, buttery start with floral aromas.

Finish:

Dark cocoa, espresso hints, and more pronounced black pepper on the retrohale. Prepare for a sweet caramel after taste that is left in the pallet that is warm and inviting.

Middle:

Soft leather, and a very smooth retrohale. Toasted cocoa and a bit of brown sugar warmth with creamy spice and aroma. The profile stays medium, flavorful, and unique.

Start:

Opens with cedar, gentle white pepper, and a natural sweet earthiness. The Criollo 98 binder adds warm, subtle spice and a touch of honey roasted nuts. The smoke is smooth and balanced.

Finish:

Expect espresso, dark chocolate, and a refined black pepper on the retrohale. Jamastran leaf elevates the finish with a clean, mineral sweetness, while the San Andrés wrapper leaves a lingering cocoa-spice aftertaste. The cigar ends long, warm, and satisfying bold, but exceptionally smooth.

Middle:

Azacualpa filler brings forward earthy richness, soft leather, and a toasted brown sugar note. Flavor becomes fuller but stays smooth. The Sumatra binder shows more character here with aromatic spice, while Jamastran contributes a clean mineral balance that keeps the profile structured and refined.

Start:

The San Andrés Habano Oscuro leads immediately with dark cocoa, natural sweetness, and a soft earthy depth. The Sumatra binder introduces a warm sweet-spice aroma, with hints of nutmeg and cedar. Jalapa adds a touch of red fruit sweetness, rounding out the opening with a creamy, silky texture.

BLEND OVERVIEW

CAFE MERANO

This cigar is built entirely from seeds traditionally grown across Nicaragua—Habano, Condega, Estelí, Jalapa but here, every leaf is cultivated and cured in the rich soils of the Jamastran Valley of Honduras. The result is a profile unlike anything produced in their native regions: smoother, sweeter, more refined, and exceptionally balanced. Jamastran's microclimate softens the edges of typically bold varietals, drawing out natural oils, sweetness, and depth while eliminating the harsh pepper bite and charred aftertaste found in younger or harsher tobaccos.

The Habano wrapper, sun-grown in the Jamastran Valley, serves as the cigar's aromatic and flavorful backbone. It presents warm cedar, gentle red and white pepper, toasted nuts, and a naturally sweet woodiness. What would normally be an aggressively spicy wrapper becomes, in Jamastran, a silky and refined expression of the seed still flavorful, but smoother and more elegant. Its dense smoke and subtle caramelized undertone carry throughout the entire cigar, setting the tone from the very first draw.

Beneath it, the Condega binder also Jamastran-grown plays the crucial role of balance and texture. Typically known for minerality and sharp pepper notes, the leaf becomes creamier and more aromatic in Honduran soil. It introduces a subtle salted-earth character, delicate herbal hints, and a warm nuttiness that rounds out the Habano's spice. The binder provides structure, helps maintain a cool, even burn, and adds a gentle creaminess that enhances the blend's overall smoothness.

The filler core begins with Estelí seed leaf, transformed dramatically by Jamastran's terroir. While Estelí grown in Nicaragua is powerful and pepper-heavy, the Jamastran-grown expression delivers a deeper, richer cocoa and a smoother black pepper bold yet refined. Its earthy foundation strengthens the cigar's middle and final third without ever overwhelming the palate, creating a confident but controlled depth.

Alongside it, Jalapa seed leaf contributes the natural sweetness and aromatic perfume that Jalapa is famous for only here, that sweetness becomes softer, rounder, and more floral. Light notes of honey, cinnamon, and creamy nuttiness weave into the blend, smoothing transitions between draws and adding a gentle lift to the heavier Estelí character. This is the leaf that adds elegance, making the retrohale fragrant and remarkably smooth.

Finally, the native Jamastran leaf brings the entire profile into harmony. Known for its clean earth, soft leather, warm wood, and mineral sweetness, this leaf provides structural balance and ensures a cool, silky smoke texture. It lengthens the finish, keeps the flavor profile consistent, and prevents any harshness or char from developing, even in the final third. Jamastran filler gives the cigar its trademark smoothness and refined finish.

Together, these five components Habano, Condega, Estelí, Jalapa, and native Jamastran interact seamlessly, each leaf reshaped by the valley that grows them. The result is a cigar defined by cedar and sweet spice at the start, rich cocoa and earth in the middle, and a long, clean, mineral-sweet finish that lingers beautifully on the palate. It is a blend rooted in strength, lifted by sweetness, and perfected by the natural smoothness only the Jamastran Valley can deliver.



BLEND OVERVIEW

SOL DORADO

This cigar is an expression of the Jamastran Valley's ability to take diverse seed varietals and mold them into a smooth, complex, and beautifully layered smoking experience. Every leaf Habano, Connecticut, Pueblo Nuevo, Jalapa, Jamastran, and Copan is grown under the same Honduran sun, in the same mineral-rich soil. The valley's unique terroir softens aggressiveness, enriches sweetness, and preserves the natural oils that give this blend its signature cream-to-cocoa evolution. Even as the wrapper alternates between two distinct seed types, the flavor never becomes disjointed. Jamastran harmonizes everything.

The Habano and Connecticut barber-pole wrapper immediately sets this blend apart not just visually, but in the way it guides the cigar's progression. The Connecticut stripe brings creamy vanilla sweetness, soft butteriness, and delicate floral notes, taming the Habano's spice. The Habano, grown in Jamastran, adds cedar, toasted nuts, warm pepper, and a touch of natural honey-like sweetness. When intertwined as a barber pole, these two leaves create a dynamic yet seamless introduction: creamy, sweet, lightly spicy, and remarkably smooth. The smoke is dense but soft, with the Connecticut rounding edges that Habano would normally sharpen.

Supporting the wrapper is the Pueblo Nuevo binder, transformed by the Jamastran Valley into a leaf of surprising depth. While Pueblo Nuevo is known for rustic earthiness, the Jamastran-grown expression becomes richer, more aromatic, and noticeably smoother. It adds warm earth, dried herb undertones, and a toasted character that deepens as the cigar progresses. The binder also contributes structural integrity, keeping the burn cool and even while adding a warm, slightly sweet layer beneath the wrapper's alternating influences.

The filler begins with Jalapa seed leaf, which brings the blend its essential sweetness and aromatic lift. In Jamastran soil, Jalapa becomes more floral, more refined, and less grassy, developing tones of honey, cinnamon, and almond. This leaf gives the cigar its smooth retrohale and helps transition the profile from the creamy opening into the richer middle third.

The native Jamastran filler provides the blend's core balance and silky finish. With notes of clean earth, soft leather, mineral sweetness, and warm wood, this leaf ensures that the cigar never becomes sharp or overpowering. It lengthens the finish and maintains the cool, steady burn that defines the Jamastran growing region. This is the leaf that keeps the profile grounded and harmonious.

Completing the trio is the Copan seed filler, which adds richness, depth, and darker complexity. Grown in Jamastran, Copan expresses itself through dark cocoa, espresso, toasted wood, and a gently sweet earthiness. This component elevates the final third, giving the cigar its boldest but still impeccably smooth finish. It deepens the smoke without introducing bitterness, offering a warm and satisfying close to the experience.

Together, these leaves tell a story of cream → warm spice → rich cocoa, all shaped by the terroir that transforms powerful tobacco seeds into smooth, elegant expressions. The barber-pole wrapper invites the smoker with sweet cream and mild spice, the Pueblo Nuevo binder enriches the mid-body with earth and toasted notes, and the Jalapa–Jamastran–Copan filler trio delivers a long, clean finish defined by cocoa, earth, floral sweetness, and effortless smoothness.



BLEND OVERVIEW

DULCE VIDA

The Habano 2000 wrapper, grown under the valley's sun, forms the cigar's flavorful outer voice. In harsher climates, this wrapper can be aggressively spicy, but Jamastran coaxes out a refined profile: warm cedar, gentle pepper, toasty nuttiness, and a subtle natural sweetness that lingers on the palate. The wrapper delivers a silky smoke texture and creates a balance of spice and wood that sets the tone from the very first draw. Its oily sheen and clean combustion demonstrate the Valley's influence strength controlled and shaped through long curing and fermentation.

Underneath, the Criollo 98 binder anchors the blend with character and continuity. Known for its rustic spice, Criollo 98 becomes smoother, deeper, and more aromatic in Jamastran soil. It adds warm grain, toasted earth, faint herbal tones, and a creamy undertone that softens the Habano 2000's spice. The binder stabilizes the burn, enhances smoke density, and provides a natural transition from the wrapper's cedar-driven opening into the richer middle body. It is the bridge between flavor and structure a leaf that binds more than the cigar itself, but the entire sensory experience.

The filler begins with the native Jamastran leaf, the backbone of smoothness and composure. This leaf is known for its clean earth, soft leather, warm wood, and mineral sweetness qualities that make Honduran cigars famous for their refinement. It ensures the blend remains cool-burning, balanced, and free from harshness, even in the final third. The Jamastran filler extends the finish and adds the signature Honduran depth that lingers after each draw.

Alongside it, the Copan seed filler, grown in the same valley, adds richness and darker complexity. While Copan grown elsewhere can be rustic and bold, Jamastran elevates it into nuanced layers of cocoa, espresso, toasted oak, and subtly sweet earth. It gives the cigar its deeper, fuller moments in the second and final third, adding a satisfying richness without overpowering the blend.

Completing the trio is the Condega seed filler, transformed beautifully in Jamastran terroir. Typically known for minerality and sharpness, Jamastran-grown Condega becomes creamy, aromatic, and far more polished. It introduces mineral sweetness, toasted nuts, soft pepper, and a delicate herbal lift that brightens the profile. Condega helps maintain balance between the richness of Copan and the smoothness of Jamastran, ensuring the cigar progresses without ever losing refinement.

Together, these components create a flavor journey defined by cedar and sweet earth at the start, toasted nuts and warm spice in the middle, and cocoa, espresso, and clean mineral sweetness in the final third. The Habano 2000 wrapper provides the aroma and initial spice, the Criollo 98 binder enriches and connects the body, and the Jamastran–Copan–Condega filler trio adds depth, structure, and an exceptionally smooth finish.

This cigar is an expression of what happens when diverse seed types are united under one terroir: complexity without aggression, richness without darkness, and smoothness without sacrifice. A complete, elegant, and deeply satisfying Honduran experience—born entirely from the Jamastran Valley.



BLEND OVERVIEW

NOCHE NEGRA

The Habano Oscuro wrapper San Andrés seed grown in the Jamastran Valley defines the cigar's presence the moment it's lit. San Andrés leaves are known for their density and their dark, cocoa-forward profile, but in Jamastran, this Oscuro becomes even more layered and refined. The wrapper offers rich notes of dark chocolate, espresso, warm earth, and a natural sweetness reminiscent of molasses or toasted sugar. What is typically a robust, heavy wrapper becomes smoother, cleaner, and more aromatic under Jamastran's influence, providing a bold yet sophisticated first impression with dense, silky smoke.

Beneath it lies the Sumatra binder, a leaf known for its unique combination of sweetness, spice, and aromatic warmth. Grown in Jamastran, Sumatra becomes more complex and less tannic, delivering a blend of sweet spice, cedar, dried fruit brightness, and toasted herbal undertones. The binder enriches the mid-body of the cigar and helps transition the wrapper's dark chocolate depths into a balanced, aromatic middle third. It also improves burn consistency and adds a subtle perfume that rises through the smoke.

The filler begins with Jalapa seed leaf, transformed in Jamastran into an elegant contributor of sweetness and smoothness. Jalapa retains its signature honeyed profile but becomes rounder and more floral in Honduran soil. Notes of cinnamon, almond, warm cane sugar, and soft cream weave naturally through the darker notes of the wrapper, adding refinement to the blend's structure and an inviting sweetness to the retrohale.

Working alongside it, the Azacualpa seed filler brings earthy power and rustic depth yet even this leaf becomes polished when grown in Jamastran. Typically known for a strong, earthy character, Azacualpa here provides a rich foundation of cocoa earth, toasted wood, and subtle spice, all delivered without the harshness it sometimes carries in other regions. It deepens the cigar's midsection and contributes to a robust but smooth final third.

Completing the filler trio is the native Jamastran leaf, which ties the entire experience together with balance and clarity. Offering soft leather, clean earth, warm wood, and a gentle mineral sweetness, this leaf ensures that the cigar never becomes overwhelming. It lengthens the finish, refines the retrohale, and maintains the cool, steady burn characteristic of Honduran-grown tobacco. It is the element that ensures the cigar evolves naturally without losing its silky core.

Together, these components create a journey that begins with dark cocoa, espresso, and sweet earth, transitions into warm spice, floral sweetness, and toasted aromatics, and finishes with deep cocoa, clean pepper, mineral sweetness, and lingering richness. The San Andrés Oscuro wrapper delivers bold flavor, the Sumatra binder adds aromatic warmth and spice, and the Jalapa–Azacualpa–Jamastran filler blend produces a long, clean, and remarkably smooth finish.

This cigar is a testament to the power of terroir: strong seeds softened and perfected by the Jamastran Valley, creating a profile that is bold in flavor yet luxurious in texture a deep, rich, and refined Honduran expression from first light to final draw.





